
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Sumner County Automated Public Safety Dispatching and Alerting System in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Gallatin, located at 132 West Main Street, Gallatin, Tennessee 37066. The funding would be used for the purchase and turnkey installation of a radio-based automated dispatching and alerting system. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project will benefit all residents and visitors of Sumner County by decreasing emergency response times by 25 percent, improving coordination, and mutual aid across agencies.
