I am requesting funding for Lebanon Police Department Event Safety, Service, & Security Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Lebanon Police Department, located at 945 East Baddour Parkway, Lebanon, TN 37087. The funding would be used for upgrading the surveillance camera systems for the James E. Ward Agricultural Center, allowing them to see better and well beyond what more officers could accomplish and at a lower cost.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project would complete the replacement of all remaining Hikvision equipment with Axis cameras, consolidate to a single network, and expand coverage to account for the area of operation.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
